Candidate Filing Dates and Location

For the August 4, 2026 Primary Election, the filing period for candidates begins at 8:00 AM on February 24, 2026 and ends at 5:00 PM on March 31, 2026.

Candidate Filing for Greene County offices will be conducted in the Greene County Clerk's Office located at 940 N Boonville Ave, RM 113 in Springfield, Missouri.

Candidate Filing Qualifications

To run as a Candidate in Greene County (Art. VII § 8, Constitution of Missouri; § 115.349.3 RSMo), all candidates must meet the following qualifications:

- United States Citizen
- Resident of the state 1 year next preceding election
- Registered voter

Changes to Candidate's Affidavit of Tax Payments and Bonding Requirements (Form 5120)

Election year is fast approaching! The Department of Revenue (DOR) is notifying candidates and those involved with elections about a new electronic process to file the required Candidate's Affidavit of Tax Payments and Bonding Requirements (Form 5120).

As mandated by Missouri statute, RSMo 115.306.2(2), individuals filing for office are required to complete Form 5120 with DOR declaring as a candidate they are not aware of any delinquency in his/her state taxes. As stated on the declaration of candidacy, this would include state income taxes, personal property taxes, municipal taxes, or real property taxes on their place of residence.

Once the filer has completed, electronically signed, and submitted the online form, the individual will receive an email with an encrypted link to their completed Form 5120. After creating a username and password, the candidate can access their completed Form 5120 which will include the date and time the form was submitted to DOR. The candidate can download and print their form, if allowed by the election authority, they can file electronically when filing for office or present the electronically filed form on a personal device. Please note: the revised form does not require notarization.

The link to Form 5120 can be accessed through the DOR website at sa.dor.mo.gov/candidate-affidavit. Election authorities and those involved in the election process are encouraged to educate individuals filing for office about this new process. Missouri Ethics Commission Forms

The candidate will receive a packet of information about the Missouri Ethics Laws and the requirements each candidate is held to under the purview of the Missouri Ethics Commission (MEC).

Notice to Candidate

This form will be completed by the candidate and witnessed by the Local Election Authority.

Greene County has an annual operating budget over \$1 million and has a conflict of interest ordinance on file with the MEC. This requires the candidate to file a Personal Financial Disclosure (PFD)/Financial Interest Statement.

If the candidate does not file a PFD/Financial Interest Statement by **April 7, 2026**, the candidate will be assessed a minimum of \$10 per date late fee for each day the report is late.

If the candidate does not file a PFD/Financial Interest Statement by **April 14, 2026**, the candidate will be disqualified as a candidate and his/her name will be removed from the ballot.

The candidate will acknowledge the receipt of written obligation to file a PFD/Financial Interest Statement and the Guide to Ethics Laws.

A photocopy of the completed and signed document will be given to the candidate for their records.

Acknowledgement of Committeepersons -Qualifications and How Selected

_____ **115.607. County or city committee, eligibility requirements, selection of.** — 1. No person shall be elected or shall serve as a member of a county or city committee who is not, for one year next before the person's election, both a registered voter of and a resident of the county or city not within a county and the committee district from which the person is elected if such district shall have been so long established, and if not, then of the district or districts from which the same shall have been taken. Except as provided in subsections 2, 3, 4, 5, and 6 of this section, the membership of a county or city committee of each established political party shall consist of a man and a woman elected from each precinct, township, or ward in the county or city not within a county. 7. If any election authority has failed to adopt a reapportionment plan by the deadline set forth in this section, the county commission, sitting as a reapportionment commission, shall within sixty days after the deadline, adopt a reapportionment plan. Changes of township, ward, or precinct lines shall not affect the terms of office of incumbent party committee members elected from districts as constituted at the time of their election.

_____ **115.613. Committeeman and committeewoman, how selected — tie vote, effect of — if no person elected a vacancy created — single candidate, effect.** — 1. Except as provided in subsection 4 of this section, the qualified man and woman receiving the highest number of votes from each committee district for committeeman and committeewoman of a party shall be members of the county or city committee of the party. 2. If two or more qualified persons receive an equal number of votes for county or city committeeman or committeewoman of a party and a higher number of votes than any other qualified person from the party, a vacancy shall exist on the county or city committee which shall be filled by a majority of the committee in the manner provided in section [115.617](#). 3. If no qualified person is elected county or city committeeman or committeewoman from a committee district for a party, a vacancy shall exist on the county or city committee which shall be filled by a majority of the committee in the manner provided in section [115.617](#). 4. The provisions of this subsection shall apply only in any county or city where no filing fee is required for filing a declaration of candidacy for committeeman or committeewoman in a committee district. If only one qualified candidate has filed a declaration of candidacy for committeeman or committeewoman in a committee district for a party prior to the deadline established in this chapter, no election shall be held for committeeman or committeewoman in the committee district for that party and the election authority shall certify the qualified candidate in the same manner and at the same time as candidates elected pursuant to subsection 1 of this section are certified. If no qualified candidate files for committeeman or committeewoman in a committee district for a party, no election shall be held and a vacancy shall exist on the county or city committee which shall be filled by a majority of the committee in the manner provided in section [115.617](#).

Candidates that wish not to be affiliated with a political party are able to run for elected positions in a General Election as independent candidates.

- The candidate must submit a signed petition to the Greene County Clerk’s Office by 5PM on the fifteenth Monday prior to the general election.
