(Vote for three.)</p> <p align="center">Vote for 3</p>	<p align="center"><b>R-6 Strafford School District</b></p> <p align="center"><b>Proposition K.I.D.S.</b></p> <p>Shall the Board of Education of the Strafford R-VI School District, Missouri, without an estimated increase in the current debt service property tax levy, borrow money in the amount of Sixteen Million Dollars (\$16,000,000) for the purpose of providing funds to expand and upgrade learning environments to support academic growth; to improve District facilities such as the Max Evans Gymnasium, Indian Plaza athletic areas, and the Auditorium with enhanced accessibility and updated public-use features; to make improvements to the agriculture building's instructional spaces; to construct an ADA-accessible playground at the elementary school; to reconfigure parking and traffic flow as needed; to the extent funds are available, complete other repairs and improvements to existing District facilities; and issue general obligation bonds for the payment thereof?
